

## Case Presentation for Practitioner Member Status Assessment

The purpose of case presentation for Practitioner Member status assessment is to demonstrate that in your practice of mediation you have reflected on problems and issues which have arisen in your mediations and have altered your practice appropriately.

Assessment requirements: to show that you have achieved knowledge, understanding and an excellence in practice.

### **Writing Up of Case Presentations**

To protect the confidentiality of parties and to ensure assessors are not compromised, the Member applicant must delete all identifying information of both parties and self (e.g. names of parties, contracting organisation, training attended etc.) in cases presentations, agreements and logs prior to submission. If there are any identifying marks the papers will be returned to you to remedy this before they are sent to an assessor.

*In general terms, one would not expect a case for assessment to exceed 3,000 words (approx 6 A4 typed pages).*
